

The 58th Academic Board of the Institute in its meeting held on August 27,0 Prof. S. Nityanand, then Executive 2020 approved the Ph.D. rules. Registrar and Member of the Ph:D. Committee desired that the amendments may be deliberated once more by the Ph.D. Committee before it is placed before the Governing Body. Accordingly, the members of the Ph.D. Committee again discussed the Ph.D. rules proposed The amended Ph.D. rules were again placed in the amendment. Academic Board. Prof. Amita Aggarwal, Head Department of Clinical Immunology and Rheumatology, has given contrary comments relating to point no. 3 & 4. The external experts were requested to comment within a week on the issue of permitting in-service faculty for PhD registration without taking one year leave as per current provision, taking inteaccount the concern expressed on sparing time for PhD work while in service and carrying out services , teaching, research supervision 🥥 student (MD/DM/MCh. & PhD).

Most of the internal and external including the chairman desired that how institute can take more admission of Ph.D. students. The suggestions of the members are given below:

- Director suggested that Faculty In-charge (Research) may encourage more Ph.D. admission and try to motivate each faculty members to have the Ph.D. Students so that Institute may public good publications. The Director, has requested the faculty members of each Department to information, their publications, area of interest, collaboration with other departments etc. so that the same can be included in the website against their departments.
- The Director, has also requested the Head of the Departments celebrate the Foundation Day of his/her departments and prepare a small documentary of about 8 to 10 minutes focusing the salish features of their departments for putting it in the website. The documentary should not be released without consent of the Director, SGPGI.

- 3. Dean, has informed that if we will take more Ph.D. students and accordingly, get more publications the Institute will gain higher rank in NAAC as well as NIRF ranking.
- 4. Prof. S.K. Sarin, Director, ILBS, suggested that Lucknow has many National Institute of repute i.e. CDRI, ITRC, NBRI, CIMAP etc. the Institute may try to get common entrance of all these Institute for getting more Ph.D. admissions. Dr. S.K. Puri, Former Director, CDRI supported the same.
- 5. Prof. Narayan Prasad, suggested if our faculty try to collaborate with the faculty of various departments (basic sciences) or in those departments where the Department has established good laboratory then they can get the Ph.D. student.
- 6. Prof. S.K. Sarin also suggested that every basic science faculty Professor/Additional/Associate Professor should have required number of Ph.D. students to remain eligible as guide/faculty as per UGC/Institutional norms.
- 7. Prof. S.K. Sarin, Director, ILBS, New Delhi, recommended the following via e-mail on Wednesday June 30, 2021:The in-service faculty should be permitted to pursue Ph.D. course, subject to the following stipulations:
 - They must complete their clinical and teaching assignments.
 - Up-to 20% total mandated time in the Institute be permitted to be utilized for research work, inclusive of travel to another Institute.

For enrolment of our faculty as Ph.D. students, the Academic Board authorized the Director, SGPGI, to decide the faculty admission in Ph.D. courses on case to case basis.

Finally, the Academic **Board approved** the amended Ph.D. Rules and Regulations, with the above recommendations.
